


SHOPPING/GROCERY

However, most shopping will be done in the dozens of boutiques that are spread throughout the area. For groceries, the neighborhood has larger places like Whole Food and Trader Joe's as well as smaller ones like Union Market. Vegetarians and vegans should also check out Orchard Grocer.



MUSIC/CULTURE

Rockwood Music Hall, Mercury Lounge, and The Bowery Electric all have a continually evolving list of up-and-coming bands, DJs. and solo artists. As for cultural institutions, check out the Tenement Museum for a closer look at 19th Century living and the New Museum for contemporary art. The Clemente Soto Velez Cultural & Educational Center and the International Center of Photography Museum are also not to be missed. Finally, the Nuyorican Poets Café has been treating guests to live jazz, poetry slams, literature, and performance art for the past 40 years.

There are just as many bars and clubs as anything else in the neighborhood, and probably more. Mr. Purple is a rooftop bar serving elegant drinks in an elegant setting, while Alphabet City Beer Co. is a casual spot with comfy chairs, rustic wood tables, and a huge selection of ales, pilsners, IPAs, stouts, and so much more. For a special night out, try Beauty & Essex, which is part pawn shop, part restaurants, and part cocktail lounge.



LEISURE






FAMILY
